NOTICE OF PUBLIC MEETING

Notice is hereby given to all interested members of the public that the Board of Directors of the above captioned District will hold a regular public meeting at 13325 ½ Kuykendahl Road, Houston, Harris County, Texas 77090, said address being a meeting place of the District.

The meeting will be held on Tuesday, September 16, 2025, at 5:30 p.m.

The Board shall consider and discuss the following matters and take any action appropriate with respect to such matters:

1. Public comments;
2. Review and approve the minutes of August 19, 2025, Board of Directors meeting;
3. Harris County Constable's Office Security Report, including security issues within the District;
4. Review and approve audit for the District's fiscal year ended May 31, 2025, and authorize execution of Annual Filing Affidavit;
5. Bookkeeper's report, including financial investment reports, and authorizing the payment of invoices presented;
6. Adoption of Resolution Adopting List of Qualified Brokers Authorized to Engage in Investment Transactions with the District;
7. Annual Review of Order Establishing Policy for Investment of District Funds and Appointing Investment Officer, and adoption of Resolution and amended Order in connection therewith;
8. Tax Assessor-Collector report, including status of delinquent tax accounts, authorizing the payment of invoices presented, approving tax refunds and moving of accounts to uncollectible roll;
9. Receive the Financial Advisor's recommendation concerning the District's proposed 2025 tax rate, determine intended tax rate, and authorize:
 - (a) the required notice that the Board will consider adoption of a tax rate; and
 - (b) the means of providing such notice;
10. Report and legal action taken by the District's delinquent tax collections attorney, authorize foreclosure proceedings, installment agreements, the filing of proofs of claim and approval of service terminations;

11. Operation and maintenance report, including:
 - (a) Authorizing the repair and maintenance of District facilities;
 - (b) Any appeals of District charges; and
 - (c) Approve write-off of uncollectible accounts, including report concerning year to date total for uncollectable accounts;
12. Engineering report, including:
 - (a) Authorizing the design, advertisement for or solicitation of bids and/or award of construction contracts or concurrence in the award of a contract for the construction and/or repair of water, sanitary sewer and drainage facilities within the District; status of construction contracts, including the approval of any change orders; and/or acceptance of facilities for operation and maintenance purposes and acceptance of site and/or easement conveyances for facilities constructed or to be constructed for the District, including:
 - (i) Water Plant No. 1 HPT Nos. 1 and 2 Replacement – CFG Industries;
 - (ii) Wastewater Treatment Plant Rehabilitation; and
 - (iii) Water Plant Nos. 1, 2, 3 and 4 Improvements;
 - (b) Discussion regarding E. Coli monitoring;
 - (c) Discussion regarding tests being conducted to determine the arsenic and iron levels in the District's water supply;
 - (d) Status of TPDES Major Permit Amendment;
 - (e) Status of Bond Application Report No. 11 for District's \$32,600,000 Unlimited Tax Bonds, Series 2025A, including review of Order of the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality authorizing issuance of same, and discussion regarding timing of the sale of the Bonds;
 - (f) Consider approval of Interim Water Supply Agreement with Rankin Road West Municipal Utility District; and
 - (g) Status of Annexation Feasibility Study for 17.4 acre tract;
13. Issuance of utility commitments;
14. Matters related to the Central Harris County Regional Water Authority;
15. Storm Water Quality Inspection report;
16. Communications report, including discussion regarding website and messaging services, and take any action necessary and appropriate in connection therewith;
17. Attorney's Report;
18. Convene executive session pursuant to Open Meetings Act, Texas Government Code Section 551.071 (consultation with attorney), and/or Section 551.072 (acquisition of real property or interests therein);

19. Reconvene in open session; authorize the taking of any action resulting from deliberations in executive session; and
20. Matters for possible placement of future agendas.
